WEST ISLAND HSSC ASKS POPULATION TO AVOID THE LAKESHORE GENERAL HOSPITAL'S EMERGENCY

Pointe-Claire, Tuesday, September 28, 2010 – The West Island Health and Social Services Centre (HSSC) administration is asking the population to avoid the Lakeshore General Hospital emergency for the next 24 hours. This decision is justified by the unusual number of patients in emergency. The emergency remains open but patients with non critical health condition may experience long waiting time.

The West Island HSSC encourages the population to opt for one of these solutions:
