SATURDAYS	For families and children aged 6 to 23 months. For those who cannot come on a weekday.

2010-2013 QMENTUM ACCREDITATION ABOUT TO BEGIN

In November 2010, Accreditation Canada will be paying us another visit. Until then, we must take part in a new accreditation process entitled Qmentum, that invites all employees to describe how they perceive the HSSC on a number of aspects. From **January 25 to February 26, 2010**, employees and managers will be required to complete three online questionnaires: the first one pertains to patient safety culture, the second one focuses on your clinical sector and the third one, entitled "Organization Efficiency" is reserved for managers. Each questionnaire takes 20 to 30 minutes to fill out. To obtain access, you will need a code and a password. You may obtain these from your manager, but you will also find them in a memorandum enclosed with your pay cheque, on the welcome page of the intranet under the **Accreditation** icon and in the workstations reserved for the Accreditation process in all four sites. These workstations are set up in the following locations:
